#### 1.0 SUMMARY

This project description summarizes how the Loveland Ready-Mix LaPorte Operations project will meet Larimer County review criteria, describes existing conditions, details proposed operations, lists existing and proposed utility and drainage infrastructure, summarizes proposed property improvements, describes the proposed access to the Project and general traffic information, and addresses any anticipated appeals to a Land Use Code standard. Potential impacts and proposed mitigation measures are described. More detailed studies are referenced herein and included as separate documents.

#### 1.1 Project Overview

Loveland Ready-Mix Concrete, Inc. (LRM) proposes the LaPorte Operations, consisting of mining sand and gravel from the Knox Pit, with a concrete batch plant. The project will be located on Larimer County Road (CR) 54G, approximately one-half mile west of Taft Hill Road and near the community of LaPorte in Larimer County, Colorado. LRM is seeking approval for the project by Special Review. The parcels on which the project will be located are identified by the Larimer County Assessor's office as 9828300001, 9828000012, 9828000013, 9828000014, 9828300017, 9828300020, and 9828300021 and each of the seven parcels is zoned O – Open. The property comprises approximately 126.58 acres. The attached Figure 1 provides a vicinity map for the project. Figure 2 depicts each of the seven properties and existing structures.


LRM proposes to produce concrete to serve the Northern Colorado community. In addition to ready-mix concrete, LRM proposes to sell recycled/crushed concrete, to be produced from waste concrete generated from site operations. This waste concrete would be residual concrete remaining in concrete mixer trucks after they return to the plant after making deliveries, washed out, allowed to dry, and then crushed to size.


#### 1.2 Neighborhood Meeting, Comments and Outreach


