**Petition Text:**

The proposal to allow industrial use (mining pits, concrete batch plant, and concrete crushing) is not compatible with the surrounding neighborhoods. The proposal does not benefit LaPorte, CO. We feel that the proposal seriously threatens the health, welfare, and safety of our community.

Attached you will find signatures from 1,402 people that were gathered from 03/02/2017 to 04/02/2017.

- Petitions collected 520 signatures and comments from 203 concerned citizens.
  - Please read comments in attached .pdf file to see why people think this operation is incompatible with the Laporte community (e.g., pollution, groundwater contamination, increased traffic, endangering neighbors and health of our food, decreased property values, etc.).
  - Citizens repeatedly comment that approval of the application would only profit one company at the detriment to the whole community.
  - Citizens want their elected officials to listen to what they have to say for a change.
  - One person's comment states "Please act as responsible stewards of our environment by denying this proposed pit."
- Ten local businesses collected 882 signatures (copies of signed signature sheets were mailed to Rob Helmick)
