	September	Larimer County Commissioners begin discussion of LRM proposal. Many LaPorte residents voice opposition. Meeting adjourned at 10 pm, to be continued.
	August	Larimer County Planning Commission recommends approval of LRM application, with modified conditions. In a highly unusual move, the Planning Commission reduced restrictions previously agreed to by LRM, and they increased hours of operation to begin at 5 am, and reduced berms from 8 to 6 feet.
	June	CDoT Reverses course, issues statement allowing direct access to 287 from Timberline property.
	June	LAPAC votes against LRM Application.
